**RESOLUTION**

**Be it Resolved:**

that the Faculty asks the ADOF/VPAA to work with other Divisions at the College to encourage the hiring of faculty spouses and partners into appropriate open and needed positions across the College.

Measures to be adopted should include, but not be limited to, the following:

- Develop and implement an institutional policy on dual-career hiring
- Make interested partners eligible to apply for open positions as internal candidates
- Allow partners to access Skidmore's existing employment services
- Develop and implement a mechanism to provide institutional perspective and oversight
