## OPTION 3 and GUIDELINESOR STUDENFACULTY COLLABORATIVE WORK

There are several options through which students and faculty may work together in the summer on collaborative projects. You and yourcolleaguesshould be aware of the distinctions mong these programs in order to serve students appropriately.

1. FacultyStudent Summer Resear@FSSRformerly known as "Collaborative Research"). This is the program adjudicated by the Faculty @topment Committee. Please be sure to read all Guidelinesand submit the appropriate forms. If your team is selected, the Office of the DOF submits the student hiringequisitionthrough OracleIf the student is not a May graduatene Office of the DOF arranges payment through Human Resources and Payroll astuditenet will receive a biweekly summer stipend; if the student is a May graduate, they will be paid hourly the current minimum wage rate and must submit timecards through Oracle to be approved by the faculty member in order to receive paymentR

NOTE: Students may not workore than the equivalent of a single fullime position on campus during the summer months. Faculty working with students in paid positions during the summer are responsible for ensuring that the totality of a student's work time does not exceed thetifule limit. In addition, please be advised that students may not hold two positions concurrently with pay arrangements (i.e., salaried/stipendand hourly).
